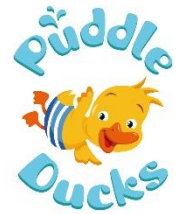


# Swimming at Euxton Pool from 4<sup>th</sup> October 2020



We are so excited to welcome you back to the pool. As with many things in life, there are some new procedures that you need to be aware of at your chosen venue. You will find everything you need to know about Euxton Pool below – please read it very carefully.

## Arrival time

Please do not arrive any earlier than 10 minutes before your lesson starts. This should give you enough time to get to the poolside and prevents lots of people from waiting around in spaces which may be too small in the current situation. Please wear a mask while walking around on poolside other than walking to get in the pool.

## Arriving swim-ready

The changing rooms and screens will not be in use for the time-being so we are asking that you and your child arrive swim-ready at the venue i.e. with your swimming costume/trunks/swim nappy on underneath your clothes.

We appreciate that those children still in nappies might need a nappy change just before their lessons. Ideally this can be done in the car before entering the building but if not, please take a change mat to the poolside with you and make sure you have nappy bags and another bag in which to put the nappy bag to ensure there is no waste left visible at poolside.

You will be asked to remove your outer clothing on poolside, please bring only the essentials (keeping valuables to a minimum) and one bag to put everything in as this will be left poolside on your chair.

We advise that you all bring a change mat that can be rolled up and placed in your bag, especially those of you who have little ones.


Level 1 and 2 swim academy children will need an adult with them in the pool as the teacher will be on the poolside for the time being.

## Face Coverings

We fall into the category of 'indoor places where social distancing may be difficult and where you will come into contact with people you do not normally meet.' Therefore, it is a requirement for all of our customers to wear a face covering except when they are in the pool.

## Spectators

Spectators are not permitted at this pool other than 1 parent for level 3 and 4 swim academy classes.



If you require assistance due to a disability (either your own disability or your child's), then you are able to bring a spectator to help as necessary.

By not allowing spectators, we are able to practice social distancing more effectively.

## Parking at the venue

Please adhere to social distancing where possible in the car park.

## Signing in/Letting us know you are here

Cameron our poolside assistant will be at the venue taking the register, he will be wearing a facemask.

## Toilets

The toilet is in use as usual.

## Changing rooms

For the time being the changing rooms and poolside screens are not in use. We are asking that customers arrive swim ready and leave in a robe or a quick dry changing towel.

## Entering the pool area

Please wash your hands before entering the pool area. The Poolside Assistant will show you where you can do this. In some cases, it might be using hand sanitiser instead of soap and water.

On arrival the poolside assistant will direct you and your child to a position marked on poolside by a chair. You can remove outer clothing here and leave your things ready for when your lesson is finished.

Please wait here, keeping socially distant from other customers and pool users wherever possible, until the teacher indicates it is time for you to enter the pool.

## Exiting the pool area after your lesson

You will be directed back to your chair after the lesson where you can collect your things and put on your robes before leaving the building. You may want to bring a onesie for your child as they are easy to get into and will keep them warm.

## Leaving the building

When you are ready to leave the building, please wash your hands or use the hand sanitiser provided and make your way to your car/mode of transport.
