

Swimming at Wirksworth Swimming Pool from April 2021



We are so excited to welcome you back to the pool. As with many things in life, there are some new procedures that you need to be aware of at the venue. This document summarises all of those changes. Arrival time

Please do not arrive any earlier than 10 minutes before your lesson starts. This should give you enough time to get poolside and prevents lots of people from waiting around in spaces which may be too small to handle it in the current situation.

Spectators

Spectators won't be allowed poolside I am afraid, however if you have siblings swimming in back to back classes you can sit poolside

If you require assistance due to a disability (either your own disability or your child's), then you are able to bring a spectator to help as necessary.

By not allowing spectators, we are able to practice social distancing more effectively.

Parking at the venue

Parking available in main car park as usual

Entering the building

Please wait at the main door, a Wirksworth team member will issue you with a sanitised box to place your belongings & shoes in, they will also check you off on the register & advise which of the 2 female changing rooms are being used for your specific lesson (these will be alternated) Please arrive swim ready & keep belongings to the absolute minimum

Signing in/Letting us know you are here

The teacher will also tick you off on the class register

Toilets

The toilets in the changing room are all in use, please maintain social distancing should you need to wait



Changing rooms

Changing rooms will be available to Puddle Ducks parents & swimmers, we have limited class sizes to 6 parents & babies & this is the maximum at any time in the changing rooms, Males attending the class will use their changing room. After your lesson, please get dried & dressed swiftly keeping to a maximum of 10 minutes in the changing room to allow the team to clean down all touch points afterwards. The changing rooms here are not large enough to allow for 2m per person, we ask adults to please wear a face covering & try to keep to 1m apart where possible.

Entering the pool area

Please only enter the poolside area a maximum of 5 minutes before your lesson, please use the poolside shower & wait for the teacher to call you over for your lesson

Exiting the pool area after your lesson

Return to the changing rooms to get dried & dressed, prioritise changing your baby & getting yourself dressed as quickly as possible please

Leaving the building

When you are ready to leave the building, please go back via the poolside & exit through the Fire Door at the opposite end, you can hand back your box on the way out
