Swimming at Hoburne Park





If you would also like to read about what, as your chosen swim school, Puddle Ducks is doing to keep you, your child and our team members safe, we have summarised all the steps we are taking including our risk assessment procedure, cleaning and hygiene regimes and temporary changes to the way our lessons will be run here.

Arrival time

Please do not arrive any earlier than 10 minutes before your lesson starts.

Arriving swim-ready

Wherever possible, you and your child should arrive swim-ready at the venue i.e. with your swimming costume/trunks on underneath your clothes. Any last minute nappy changes etc can take place in the changing rooms.

Spectators

Unfortunately spectators are not allowed currently.

If you require assistance due to a disability (either your own disability or your child's), then you are able to bring a spectator to help as necessary.

Entering the building

Adults should wear a face covering inside the building, however it is now longer necessary to wear a mask on poolside – please leave your mask in your locker with your belongings. Please use the hand sanitiser on entry into the building and walk through to the pool entrance. Please remove your outdoor shoes.

Changing rooms

Changing rooms are available, and Hoburne Park will be cleaning regularly. Lockers are available for use. Ideally, you should arrive "swim ready". On exit, cubicles will be available for changing. You should have a quick towel down and change – please be ready to leave within 10 minutes of your lesson finishing. This is to allow Hoburne Park access to clean regularly.

Entering the pool area

Follow the one-way system around the changing rooms which will bring you to an entrance to the poolside, line up on your furthest marker.

Exiting the pool area after your lesson

You should climb out of the pool as instructed by your teacher and turn right to walk around the pool and to the changing rooms. Showers are available but are only for quick rinse.

Please ensure you follow the one way system to go back to your locker and then to a cubicle. We ask that you change quickly and leave within 10 minutes to allow Hoburne Park as much time as possible to clean. We advise that you bring easy, comfortable clothing for both you and your child – items like onesies might be easiest for children to get changed quickly and keep them warm.

Leaving the building

When you are ready to leave the building, please wash your hands or use the hand sanitiser provided and make your way back out of the changing rooms and back to your car.
