

# Swimming at Hoburne Bashley



You will find everything you need to know about Hoburne Bashley below – please read it very carefully.

If you would also like to read about what, as your chosen swim school, Puddle Ducks is doing to keep you, your child and our team members safe, we have summarised all the steps we are taking including our risk assessment procedure, cleaning and hygiene regimes and temporary changes to the way our lessons will be run [here](#).

## Arrival time

Please do not arrive any earlier than 10 minutes before your lesson starts.

## Arriving swim-ready

Wherever possible, you and your child should arrive swim-ready at the venue i.e. with your swimming costume/trunks on underneath your clothes, however nappy changes etc can take place in the changing rooms.

## Spectators

Unfortunately spectators are not allowed currently.

If you require assistance due to a disability (either your own disability or your child's), then you are able to bring a spectator to help as necessary.

## Entering the building

Adults should wear a face covering whilst in the building, but should leave it in your locker with your belongings rather than wearing it poolside. Please use the hand sanitiser on entry into the building and walk through to the pool entrance. Please remove your outdoor shoes on entry to changing rooms.

## Changing rooms

Changing rooms are available, and Hoburne Bashley will be cleaning regularly. Lockers (£1 refundable) are available for use so place everything in here (including your mask). Ideally, you should arrive "swim ready". On exit, cubicles will be available for changing. You should have a quick towel down and change – please be ready to leave within 10 minutes of your lesson finishing. This is to allow Hoburne Bashley to clean any touchpoints ready for the next users.

## Entering the pool area

Enter the pool area via the usual route. Follow the one-way system around the changing rooms which will bring you to an entrance to the poolside. Walk straight ahead and line up on a marker until the previous class have exited past you and the teacher asks you to move forward to a safe station and enter the pool.



## Exiting the pool area after your lesson

You should climb out of the pool as instructed by your teacher and walk back towards the changing cubicles.

We ask that you change quickly and leave within 10 minutes to allow Hoburne Bashley as much time as possible to clean. We advise that you bring easy, comfortable clothing for both you and your child – items like onesies might be easiest for children to get changed quickly and keep them warm.

## Leaving the building

When you are ready to leave the building, please wash your hands or use the hand sanitiser provided and make your way back out of the changing rooms and through the building as usual.
