

Swimming at Woolley Grange Hotel from September 2021



This document explains what moving to Step 4 of the Government Roadmap means for your swimming lessons from September 2021. You can be assured that, along with our governing body, STA, we will continue to put your safety and the safety of our teams as our top priority.

Arriving at the pool and changing

- Changing rooms will be available at Woolley Grange before and after your lesson. Adults should arrive swim-ready, in order to minimise time spent in an enclosed space with others.
- Please arrive no more than 10 minutes before the start of your lesson, and be poolside ready for the start of your lesson.
- Showers will be available and are encouraged before and after your lesson.
- Please leave the changing rooms promptly after class as space is limited – thank you.

Spectators

- No spectators will be permitted.
- If you require assistance due to a disability (either your own disability or your child's), then you are able to bring a spectator to any class, to help as necessary.

Poolside Assistants

- A Puddle Ducks Poolside Assistant will not be present, as cleaning and registration will be undertaken by the venue's team instead.

Face coverings

- Customers should wear face coverings inside the venue if they wish, but not in the pool. Our team members will still wear face coverings as they move around the building.

Hand washing

- Please continue to wash your hands before entering the pool area. At some venues this may be with hand sanitiser instead of soap and water.
